ONTARIO RECREATIONAL CANOEING ASSOCIATION COURSES

In order to achieve ORCA Basic A & B, a one week course is sufficient. A two week course is necessary to complete Basic C and three weeks for Basic D. Boys planning to earn their ORCA Flatwater Level 1 & 2 must be prepared to make a major time commitment during the month. Early morning practices will be scheduled. Five canoeing lessons each summer are mandatory until a boy has passed his ORCA Basic C award.

CANOE TRIP EXEMPTION

In our opinion, every boy should go on the canoe trip with his group. Boys who miss the trip invariably lose contact with their fellow cabin-mates and feel excluded after the group returns. However, if your son has experienced two trips of at least four days in duration which included at least two portages, he may be excused from his canoe trip if he does not wish to go and you authorize him to miss it. If you wish to do this, please write us a note to this effect.

CANADIAN YACHTING ASSOCIATION SAILING

In order to achieve a sailing award, we recommend for White Sail 1 & 2, a one week course. Boys taking White Sail 3, Bronze 4 and Bronze 5 require a three week course. An advanced sailing manual is required for the Bronze 4 & 5 course, which can be ordered through the Ontario Sailing Association.

A SPECIAL NOTE TO BRONZE SAILORS: CYA Bronze 4 and 5 awards are difficult to achieve and require a great deal of time and effort. Bronze candidates will have a 2 hour sailing lesson per day and possibly a lecture as well. It is strongly recommended that the Bronze candidates use 5th period for racing in order to improve their sailing ability. It is not uncommon for a Bronze sailor to take two summers at camp to complete these awards.
