

2010 INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF TWO WEEK CAMPERS

JULY

Arrival- Wednesday, June 30th
Departure- Tuesday, July 13th

AUGUST

Arrival- Sunday, August 1st
Departure- Saturday, August 14th

TRAVEL TO CAMP

Boys arriving **June 30th or August 1st** have the option of taking the bus from Toronto/Pickering or arriving by car between 2:00-5:00 pm.

Boys arriving **July 14th or August 15th** by car should arrive **between 2:30 pm-4:00 pm.**

TRAVEL FROM CAMP

Boys departing on **July 13th or August 14th** by car should be picked up no later than 1:00 pm.

Boys departing on **July 27th or August 28th** have the option of taking the bus home to Toronto/Pickering or being picked up by car, no later than 1:00 pm.

At least one car ride is necessary since there is no bus available during the middle of the month!

Course Enrollment: If interested in riding, 2 week campers are encouraged to enrol for 5 riding lessons. Canoeing lessons will be arranged after completion of the distance swim, (Raft Test). We discourage enrolment in a formal sailing course, which takes too much time in a 2 week session. If your son wishes to sail on a “daily sign up” basis please indicate on the course enrollment sheet. Often, younger boys find swimming lessons in the lake to be more challenging than courses offered in a pool setting, due to waves and colder temperatures. On occasion, we will have a boy repeat a swim level he has already achieved if he is finding the higher level arduous.

Visiting: We discourage a parental visit during the two week stay. Please allow enough time for a tour of camp and a visit with your son’s counselor on arrival or departure day.

Tuck Expenses: Of the \$35 tuck deposit, less than \$10 is spent on candy. The boys are allotted 3 pieces per week! At the tuck shop, the boys may purchase stamps, a camp hat, insect repellent, a replacement toothbrush, sunscreen etc. Award costs for swimming and canoeing will be assigned. The tuck shop does not create revenue for the camp. It exists to provide the necessities for each boy’s stay. At the end of the session, any money left over will be returned to you or your son. Any balance owing can be settled on departure day or after camp.

Campwide Photo : Only the boys in the **first** two weeks will be present for the camp wide photo.
